Launched recently, Royal Coast Walks can take you on a unique overnight hiking adventure in the Royal National Park. After a decade working and traveling overseas, local lad Ian Wells has returned to create an unforgettable experience for you on his favourite walk, The Coast Track.

Get back in touch with nature on a two-day camping trip, which will take you along the entire length of the 30km coast track, renowned for its dramatic, diverse and spectacular scenery.

The Bushwalk itself begins after catching the ferry from Cronulla to Bundeena. Strolling along Jibbon Beach to the Dharawal carvings through rugged scrub before rejoining the cliff edge on the way to Marley beaches. Continuing south towards Wattamolla it's time for a refreshing swim at the secluded lagoon before settling down at camp under the stars, dining on sumptuous food and sharing stories.

On day two the adventure continues exploring the rocky

inlet of Curracurrang to Garie's North Head with spectacular views extending to the southern end of the Royal National Park and Sea Cliff Bridge. After taking a refreshing swim at Garie Beach the walk continues around the historical fisherman's huts at Era and Burning Palms before the climb up through a littoral forest to Otford where you exit the park.
